


Workshops

Workshops are conducted by professional lecturers at our offices in Edinburgh. This is the chance to brainstorm ideas in order to create the Edinburgh travel guide. Workshops are in place as a guide to point the team members to the right direction in order to create an appealing guide which includes cutting edge photos, reviews, an attractive layout, itineraries, the history, art, fashion, culture and the best bits of Edinburgh for visiting young people.

Free copies of the travel guide are published online and as an E-Book, to tourist places of interest, including backpacking hostels, bed and breakfasts, the airport and local tourist offices. Some projects incorporate presenting your findings to the Edinburgh tourist board. The aim of the programme is to do something productive and worthwhile with your gap experience, exploring a new city whilst gaining experience which is both fun and valuable.

We arrange activities, excursions and project related visits, reports of which can be incorporated in the guide booklet. Upon satisfactory completion, each participant receives the necessary papers as proof of work experience.



How to apply?



What is included in the cost?

- Workshops with professional lecturers/media experienced staff and culture classes
 - Programme timetable, professional staff, project related visits, activities and excursions accompanied by members of our team
 - If accepted on to the programme, the fee for the programme (3 weeks plus preparation, publishing and evaluation) is 1199 EUR exactly.
 - Accommodation for the one day (Sun) before the workshops/meetings begin is also included.
 - Use of project rooms for meetings, workshops (incl. WLAN)
 - Copy of completed work (download, E-Book) plus online distribution. Organised team working tasks and basic equipment required.
 - All references as proof of completion
- Pick up from airport. We are taking care of your departure arrangements as well.
 - Accommodation in fully equipped apartment located in/near the city centre in a lovely location.
 - All bed linen
 - Basic breakfast items for the start of the project
